

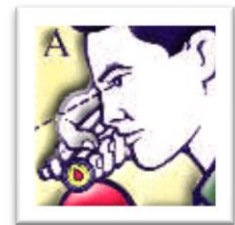
How to use a Fire Extinguisher

- * Fire extinguishers are designed to be used on small fires
- * Always ensure that there is an exit route behind you in case you can't put the fire out
- * Start firing the extinguisher when you are about 2 to 3 metres from the fire

P Pull the pin to break the tamper seal



A Aim at the base of the fire



S Squeeze the handle to begin discharging the extinguishers



S Sweep the nozzle from side to side keeping the extinguisher aimed at the base of the fire



- * In most cases you will need to empty the entire contents of the extinguisher
- * Once the fire is out keep watching it while you back away in case it reignites
- * If you can't extinguish the fire, evacuate immediately and call the Fire Service 111
